It's cross-cutting methodology that facilitates people's access to local services and opportunities, enhances awareness, information and cultural advancements among citizens, allows the maintenance of immigrants' culture and ties to their own origins.

INDIVIDUALIZED PROGRAMS



Specifically tailored to individual needs, and requiring the activation of beneficiaries, individualized programs aim to accompany people in the exit from conditions of difficulty to their full inclusion in the relational and social environment.

OUTREACH AND LOW THRESHOLD WORK



Proximity to communities, staying inside and alongside, mitigating negative effects of harmful behaviours, never acting in place of people, but actually promoting initiative and self-care.
